Cambridgeshire County Council Invoice Payments 2019/20

Regulation 113(7) of the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 (and as set out in Procurement Policy Note 03/16 issued by Crown Commercial Services) introduced the following publication requirements:

After March 2017, all in-scope organisations must publish, on an annual basis and covering the previous 12 months,

- i) the percentage of their invoices of suppliers and prime contractor's invoices* paid within 30 days
- ii) the amount of interest paid to suppliers due to late payment and iii) the total amount of interest that the contracting authority was liable to pay (whether or not paid and whether under any statutory or other requirement), due to a breach of Regulation 113.
